#### 2023 OUTREACH REPORT CARD

We help not only our own parishioners but also people and families in our community and families in our local schools. We help with all sorts of bills from rent to food. Here is our 2023 Outreach Report Card: We received a total of \$10,715 in donations during 2023. Here is a breakdown of all expenses for 2023: Rent-\$2065.00, Electric-\$1529.90, Car insurance-\$173.90, Repair-\$2090.03, Heating-\$403.78, Garbage-\$100.50, Food cards-\$2674.00(this includes Easter, Thanksgiving, and Christmas). Total expenses-\$9,037.11. Easter, we helped 35 families with 61 Easter Baskets and full meals. Thanksgiving we helped 27 families Thanksgiving dinners, and Christmas we helped 32 families with full dinners and Christmas presents enough for 90 children. We have super generous parishioners who come to the rescue every holiday, they truly take to heart the words of Jesus, "feed my sheep". May God bless you with abundant graces this New Year!


