

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY, APRIL 27TH

By participating in this Feast our souls have the opportunity for all our temporal punishments from our sins to be wiped clean. In other words, when we sin we go to confession to have the priest forgive our sins. Each sin has a punishment attached to it called

a temporal punishment that the priest <u>cannot</u> <u>remove</u>. In order to remove the temporal punishments of our sins we could spend extra time in purgatory or we can participate in spiritual activities which can grant us plenary indulgences.

Some examples would be: •going to confession 20 days before or after obtaining the indulgence; •receiving Eucharistic communion; •praying for the intentions of our Pope; •praying in front of the Blessed Sacrament at least ½ hour; •participation in the Adoration of the Cross on Good Friday; •praying at least 5 decades of the rosary in church/chapel/in a community/pious family/religious association; •celebrating at a priests first solemn Mass or his 25th, 50th, or 60th anniversary Mass; •visiting a church on the day of its dedication and praying 1 Our Father and the Creed; •renewing one's Baptismal promises during the Easter Vigil or on the anniversary of one's Baptism; •reading sacred Scripture with devotion to God's Word for at least 30 minutes; •piously praying the Stations of the Cross; each Friday during Lent recite the prayer "Look down Upon Me, Good and Gentle Jesus" after communion before an image of Christ crucified; •local Bishops may also impart Apostolic blessing three times a year on dates of their choosing at the end of a special solemn Mass. •BUT THE MOST IMPORTANT IS PARTICIPATING IN THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY. CATHOLIC SCHOOL 2025-2026 TUITION ASSISTANCE

Families interested in applying for tuition assistance to attend an eligible Diocese of Metuchen elementary or high school may apply online now through FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment at https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. Online applications must be completed (including all required documentation) by no later than March 31, 2025. A signed Parish Verification Form is also required by the Diocese, and should be signed by your Pastor, and submitted to the school or schools your children attend. Eligibility requirements, instructions and forms can be found at https://diometuchen.org/tuition-assistance. Applications are available in English and Spanish.

Families that need assistance completing the online application or need access to a computer to apply should contact their school.

2025 THE JUBILEE-YEAR

History of the Jubilee Year: The first Jubilee Year was instituted in 1300 by pope Boniface VIII. established to help us grow closer to God, to transform our souls. It was to take place every 100 years. In 1343 Popel Clement VI reduced the time between Jubilee Years to 50 and in 1470 Pope Paul II made it every 25 years. This year 2025 Pope Francis has declared this a Jubilee Year or in other words a "Holy Year". In this Holy Year, one is granted a plenary indulgence or Jubilee Indulgence by participating through pilgrimage and prayer. You can travel to Rome to the Basilica of St. Peter or our Bishop has designated the following places within the Diocese of Metuchen: Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi, Metuchen, Shrine Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament, Raritan, National Blue Army Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, Washington, or the National Shrine of St. Lucy Filippini (inside St. Mary of Mt. Virgin Church), New Brunswick. To obtain the indulgence you must 1) receive Holy Communion, 2) pray for the intention of the Holy Father, 3) sincere intention to detach from all sin and go to confession, 4) participate in liturgical celebrations or other designated religious activities connected to the Jubilee Year.
