

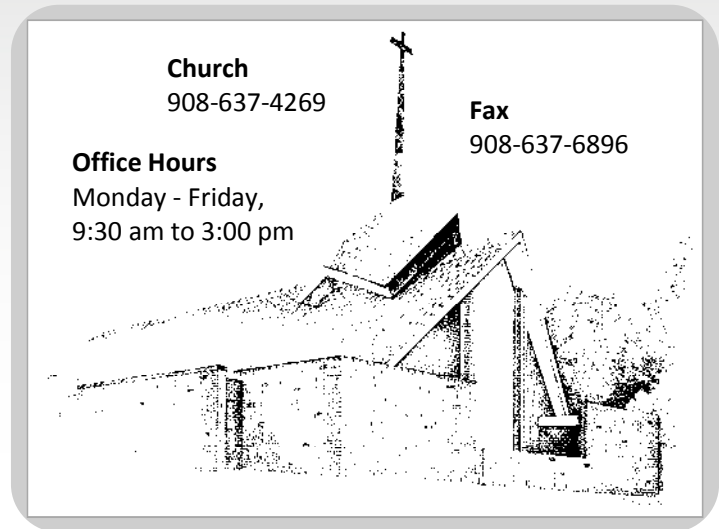

CONFESSION: Saturday, 4:00 - 4:50 pm (*before the 5:00 pm Mass*) and before the 8:30 am Mass (*by appointment only*).

BAPTISMS: Class and arrangements must be made by contacting the Rectory. If you are a newly registered family you are required to be attending Mass for at least 3 months and using offering envelopes.

MARRIAGES: Requirements... Marriage preparation classes and Confirmation (*if you are Catholic*). Arrangements are to be made at least six months in advance. At least 3 meetings with the priest are required.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Classes are held for Parish registered members only on Sunday mornings from mid September to May. Children seeking their sacraments must attend all 8 years of a Religious Education Program. Call 908-637-4269.

Mission Appeal for Patagonia

Next Weekend **-June 23/24-** is our Mission Appeal Weekend. This year we are invited to support the missionary work of **Prelature of Esquel (Patagonia)** in the country of Pope Francis, Argentina. This mission was created in 2009 and covers more than 30,000 square miles and has a population of about 70,000 habitants. Presently six diocesan priests and five religious (seven Polish Redemptorists) serve in eleven parishes in the new Prelature. The people in these communities are very poor and unable to support their parishes. Without funds collected during this Mission Appeal, the Prelature of Esquel cannot sustain its pastoral work e.g. evangelization activities, children and youth catechetical programs, lay ministry training and help for the poor. Blessed Pope John Paul II reminded us in his encyclical 'Rich in Mercy': "Jesus Christ taught that man not only receives and experiences the mercy of God, but that he is also called to practice mercy towards others."
