MASSES INSIDE THE CHURCH



MASSES will be celebrated in our church on Saturday at 5pm and in English on Sunday mornings at 7:30am and 9am. Mass in Polish will be celebrated on Sunday at 10:30am. Masks must be worn and social distancing must be maintained. The church will be marked with blue tape indicating where you can sit. We are allowed 100 people inside the building at this time. We suggest you also bring your own hand sanitizers. We will only take up one collection, so please put your second collection envelopes/donations in the first collection. Offertory gifts (host & water & wine) will not be brought up to the altar. We will not need the services of our Altar Servers. As you approach the Altar for communion, the floor will be marked helping us stay 6 feet apart. Please lower your mask and consume the host and raise your mask back in place. When you get back to your pew please sanitize your hands. We ask that everyone receive the Body of Christ in the hand, however, if you feel you need to receive on the tongue please go to Fr. Greg only. When leaving the church please wipe down your area with wipes if you have them and remember to social distance yourselves.
