Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of innocent victims of violence in the Middle East who are struggling to survive, protect their children, and live with dignity in dire conditions. The Holy Father continues to call for a cease fire and for aid to enter the territory, noting with great sorrow that "Gaza is starving." The Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) is there providing vital emergency humanitarian relief and medical and psychological care for the sick, malnourished and wounded. - -Reception of Holy Communion
- -Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father
- -A sincere intention to detach from all sin, even venial sins, and, if necessary, going to confession
- -Participate in liturgical celebrations or other designated religious activities connected to the Jubilee Year.
- Please do this before December 8, 2025.
