of all animals. Please remember to make sure all pets are secure and on leashes or in cages.


FIRST FIRDAY

Traveling Eucharistic Rosary Congress

A Jubilee Year is a Holy Year for the forgiveness of sin, conversion and joyful celebration. During this Jubilee of Hope, we are encouraged to renew our relationship with Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, and to encounter His healing grace. We have the perfect opportunity to do so this October 4th, during the Traveling Eucharistic Rosary Congress. A Traveling Eucharistic Rosary Congress is seven days of around-the-clock Eucharistic Adoration, including an Hourly Rosary, with each 24-hour period hosted by a different parish. This year's Congress features eight parishes, spread throughout the diocese. During each 24-hour period, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed following morning/afternoon Mass, with the Rosary prayed aloud at the start of each hour, followed by silent prayer for the remainder of the hour. We encourage all parishioners to participate in this year's Congress by volunteering to cover at least one hour of Adoration at a parish near you. Pope Leo XIV recently imparted his Apostolic Blessing to the Eucharistic Congresses, "invoking a fresh outpouring of heavenly graces" to the participants, commending them "to the maternal protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary that by the witness of generous and faithful hearts the Flame of Hope may always shine brightly in our world." We hope that you will join us in this wonderful celebration at the Blue Army Shrine in Asbury, NJ on Saturday, October 4th. Please see the bulletin board for details.
