CHRISTMAS WAFERS

Are available in the back of the church. Each envelope contains 3 wafers. The asking donation is \$5 per package. Family members and friends break off a small piece of the *oplatek* wafer and give it to one another along with a blessing. Breaking off and exchanging part of the *oplatek* with someone is a symbol of forgiveness and is meant to remind participants of the importance of Christmas, God, and family.

A sample blessing can take the form of "I wish you much health, happiness and the Lord's bountiful blessings as well as the fulfillment of all your plans and everything



you wish for yourself" or just wishing good grades to a child and good health to your parents. It is also common to put a "shared piece" into the Christmas card you are sending. The tradition of sharing the wafer is one of the rich variety of traditions that the Polish community still celebrate during Christmas Eve Supper which is the most elegant and pompous evening in the whole year.
