

CHRISTMAS WAFERS / OPŁATEK

Just before the Christmas Eve meal (in Polish -Wigilia) the entire family will gather around the table with the Christmas Wafer or Oplatki. Generally, the eldest member of the family will begin the ritual by breaking off a piece of the wafer and passing it to another family member with a blessing. blessing can simply consist of what you desire for your loved one in the upcoming year - whether it be good health, success, or happiness. The wafer passes from person to person until all have had a piece and all have been given a blessing. The purpose of this act is primarily to express one's unconditional love and forgiveness for each member of his or her family. This symbolism is deepened by the fact that the name of the town where Jesus Christ was born, Bethlehem, means "House of Bread," which makes the Oplatki tradition an especially beautiful way to celebrate the charity and unity so characteristic of the Christmas season. Many families include the wafers in Christmas cards to family members in distant locations. The tradition can easily be shared in this way with anyone around the world! Christmas wafers are available here in our church. The asking donation for a packet of wafers is only \$5.00.

KEEPING CHRIST IN CHRISTMAS

Some tips on keeping Christ in Christmas:

- Place an electric candle in a window symbolizing the light of Christ
- Listen to traditional Christmas carols that honor Christ's birth
- Find religious Christmas wrapping paper decorations
- Read Christmas scripture and stories to children
- Purchase a gift and give it to the poor, encourage your children to do the same.
- Explain the original Christmas tree tradition to your children
- Use decorations, cards, etc., with Merry Christmas instead of "Happy Holidays"
- Have your children place a piece of straw in the creche each day that they do a good deed during Advent
- Pray for the young, so that when they become adults they will not regard Christmas as just another holiday free from work
